Allied Waste Services annual cost adjustment of the Solid Waste Handling is \$.18 per residence.

Gary advised that the Streets and Public Nuisance Committees would need to meet soon to look at the trees, sidewalks, grass etc. in the Village. The Fire Department will meet on May 29th at 7 pm to discuss a new truck. They have requested 2 members of the Village Board attend this meeting.

Gary advised that Ron Fladseth has resigned from the Village Board, effective May 16th, 2013.
