Ryan will be checking with the County and other sources to see if there are any funds available. He has plans to order bulk product with the Cuba City or Shullsburg (this depends on the product we use) to keep the costs down.

Beverly Hitz presented a vacation request for June 20 through July 7, 2019.

Gary McCrea has received a request to build on to the current Business Incubator Building. Jill Knight will put together a meeting for the BBI as a starting point to discuss this request.

Jill Knight has plans to start investigating ways to obtain new equipment for our parks. She will be working with Stacey Addie on this project.

The claims against the Village were presented for payment.
